Work Schedule

Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. If necessary, some work may be performed overnight or during the weekend.

Mitigation Measures

Measures are implemented to limit the inconvenience to residents living near the job site. These measures include:

- performing the work mainly during the day;
- · noise-reduced blades for concrete saws;
- noise-monitoring by teams on the job site to ensure compliance with the approved noise levels.
