### ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS AGENT

*The Green Patrol is currently recruiting individuals passionate about the environmental cause to join its citizen awareness mission.*

#### Job description

The agent's mission is to sensitize Montrealers about various environmental issues. They will be the proud representatives of the Green Patrol and they will have an important role in mobilizing and encouraging the community in adopting habits that are more ecologically or environmentally sound.

In order to fulfill their mission, they will be called upon to perform the following tasks:

- Conduct **door-to-door** tours;
- Hold **informational kiosks** in public places;
- Animate **educational and environmental workshops** for various populations;
- Support eco-quartiers in carrying **summer greening projects**;
- Attend the **trainings** on different covered themes (waste management, urban forest, water management, ecological transition) and on environmental education techniques;
- **Compile data** in digital reports;
- Carry out any other related task.

#### Work Conditions

- Seasonal job, outdoor work ;
- May 30<sup>th</sup> to August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (may end sooner depending on the work area)
- 32 hours per week (flexible hours with possibilities of work in the evening and on weekends) ;
- Salary: 16,00\$ per hour ;
- Protection measures in place to ensure the safety of patrollers and citizens in the context of COVID-19.

## Requirements

- Be between **15 and 30 years of age** at the start of the employment ;

- Have a valid **Social Insurance Number** at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
