
Constructions begin

Traffic and parking



- The westbound driving lanes will be narrowed to one lane, and the north-side parking lane will temporarily be removed;
- Alternative facilities for cyclists as needed;
- To ensure safety and optimize traffic flow during the work, please respect on-site signage (detours, local traffic, etc.);



- The contractor is required to set up a safe worksite perimeter and may use parking spaces for materials or equipment;
- Entrances to residences and other buildings will be accessible at all times.

Construction site information



- Schedule: Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.;
- Obstruction 24/7;
- Operations may include repairing sidewalks, asphalting and marking (painted road signs);
- Measures have been taken to mitigate the noise, vibrations, dust and odours
 caused by the use of tools and other equipment required to carry out the work.

Road network maintenance

Despite the freeze and thaw cycles, heavy traffic and the circulation of large vehicles that weaken the roads, maintenance of the road network is given special attention in order to preserve a comfortable and safe roadway for everyone.

- Minimize environmental impact by recycling asphalt;
- Maintain a roadway better adapted to traffic needs;
- Promote a pleasant and safe environment for pedestrians, cyclists and motorists.

Where are the workers?



According to the project, important steps involve waiting time periods. As planned, worksite remain on course even though operations are suspended. Meanwhile, for efficiency reasons, workers are temporarily assigned to another project. The most common awaiting periods are: pending drinking water tests results, electrical functional tests results, unsuitable weather conditions, vacation and holidays.
